

Abstract of Deed dated June 7, 1788
Recorded March 30, 1789

Grantors: Johan Peter Walradt, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Grantee: Jacob Walradt, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Consideration: 345 Pounds

Description of land: All that land in the District of Canajohary where Hendrick Schrimling lately lived being butted and bounded as follows:
Beginning on the division lines of the lands of Martin Van Alysten between him and his brother Cornelius VanAlstyn (at the River) and running from there up the River 15 chains, then keeping the same breadth striking into the woods 15 chains then West 3 chains then into the woods with a breadth of 18 chains a Southerly course 47 chains to the lands heretofore granted to Jeremiah Quackenbos and from thence along said Quackenbos line 18 chains, from thence along said Cornelius VanAlstyn's line to the place of beginning the same being a tract or farms of land which Hendrick Schrimling by deeds of lease and release bearing the 26 & 27 days of February 1787 conveyed and released to Johann Peter Walradt.
