Description of land: Beginning at a stake on the South bank of the Mohawk River running in Lot 130 6 links Northeasterly from a butternut tree corner and from there North 56 degrees West up the River 3 chains and 34 links to a stake on the bank of the River then South 34 degrees West 3 chains to a stake then South 56 degrees East 3 chains and 34 links to a stake and heap of stone then North 34 degrees East 3 chains to the place of beginning containing 1 acre of land.
