

Abstract of Deed dated February 27, 1793
Recorded November 1, 1799

Grantors: John Jacob Beekman, Esq. & Maria Beekman, wife, of City of Albany, N.Y.

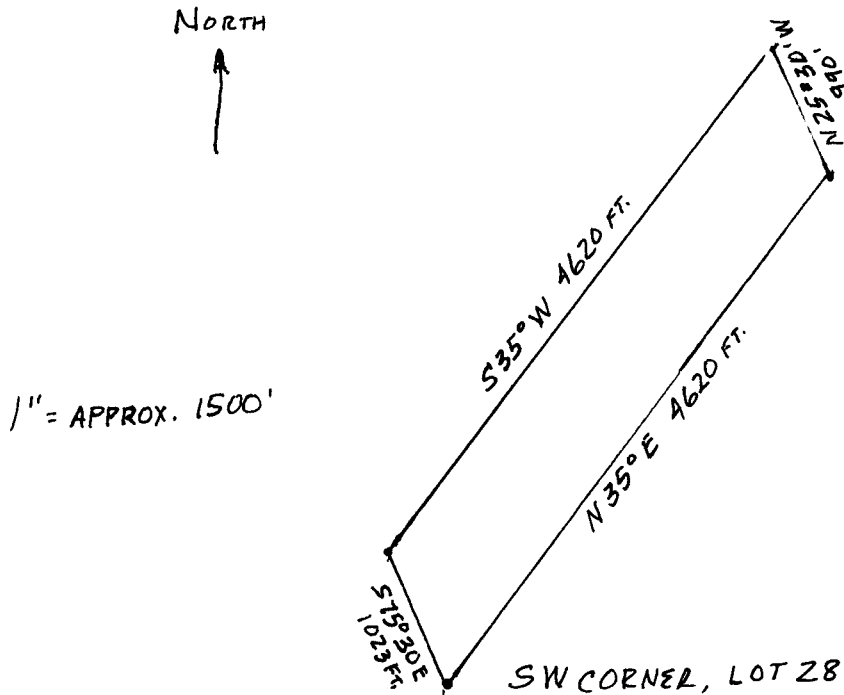
Grantee: Jacob Henry Walrath, Jun. & Rebecca Walrath, wife, Palatine, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Consideration: One Hundred and Fifteen Pounds

Description of land: All that certain Lot of land called Lot number twenty nine in a patent granted to George Klock and others on the North side of the Mohawk River near the Canada Creek and beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot number twenty eight and runs North thirty five degrees East seventy chains then North twenty five degrees thirty minutes West fifteen chains then South thirty five degrees West seventy chains then South seventy five degrees and thirty minutes East fifteen chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing in all about one hundred five acres of land.

Witnesses: John Lansing, Justice of Supreme Court,

Note: The instrument references the land as being in Jacob's actual possession and having been Peter H. Walrath's share in the land as conveyed to him by his father which was subject to several mortgages to John Jacob Beekman. The five shillings must have represented the balance owing on said mortgages.
