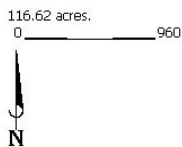
Grantors: Adolph & Catharine Walrad, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Description of land: Town of Canajohary. All that land lying on both sides of a brook called Bowman's Kill, being part of a Patent granted to William Dick, Frederick Morris, and others, and known as Lot 6 and begins at a marked spruce tree standing in the middle line in the division of Lot 5 & Lot 6 then South 64 chains & 50 links then North 67 degrees West 11 chains & 50 links then North 51 chains to a small marked maple tree in the middle line then forward the same course 18 chains & 30 links then North 16 degrees & 15 minutes East 40 chains then South 72 degrees East 9 chains & 25 links then South to the place of beginning containing 125 acres and taken from a deed of release for the same premises from T____ Schaaf and Maria, his wife to Hendrick Diefendorf dated October 11, 1769.
