

**Abstract of Deed dated September 30, 1817
Recorded February 15, 1821

Description of land: In a patent granted to Lewis Morris and others, in the Town of Canajohary, being part of the farm formerly conveyed by John Rooseboom to Adam Brower beginning at a point in the center of the River Road in a course 43 degrees & 30 minutes West 2 chains & 20 links from the Northwest corner of the house now occupied by John O'Brian from there South 65 degrees & 45 minutes East through the middle of the road 14 chains & 52 links to the house lot of John J. Van Slyck then South 30 degrees West 9 chains & 80 links on the West bounds of said lot and the lands of Jacob Walradt then North 60 degrees West 2 chains & 78 links then South 29 degrees West 4 chains to a stone fence dividing the lands of Emmanuel Gunsolus and Jacob Walradt then North 60 degrees West 14 chains & 52 links then North 29 degrees East 4 chains then North 46 degrees East along the East bounds of the land lately purchased by Nicolas Van Alstine of Emmanuel Gunsalus 11 chains & 24 links to the place of beginning containing 22 acres 1 rood & 25 perches of land RESERVING the road now running through the conveyed premises by a gate erected on the upper part of the road the use of which is to provide access to the premises on the hill.
