Grantors: Jacob J. & Gertrude Walradt, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Grantee: John J. Van Slyck, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Consideration: \$125.00

Description of land: Town of Canajohary, beginning at the Easterly line of John Rosebooms land where it strikes the _____ at low water mark and runs along said line South 29 degrees West 3 chains & 34 links to a stone then South 55 degrees East 3 chains to a stake & stones then North 29 degrees East 3 chains & 34 links to the river then up the river to the place of beginning containing 1 acre of land.

Witness: Abraham Roseboom, Jacob Walradt, Jun.

Note: It is worth noting that although the name of the farm is spelled *Rooseboom* it was witnessed by Abraham *Roseboom*. Also, Gertrude signed as *Gertrey* and is likely Gertrude *Dockstader*. Jacob signed as *Jacob J. Walradt*. The Roseboom farm was located in the patent granted to Lewis Morris & others.
