Description of land: Canajoharie, in a patent granted to William Dick, being my $\frac{1}{2}$ share of the land granted to Catherine & Adolphus Walradt by Adam Bowman dated $\frac{7}{4}$ 1787, being part of Lot No. 8, beginning at a certain marked maple tree in the division line of Lot 7 & Lot 8 then South 57 chains & 25 links then North 67 degrees **(rest of line missing)** then North 53 chains & 50 links to the middle line to a marked maple tree then the same course23 chains then South 72 degrees East 11 chains & 25 links then South 16 degrees & 15 minutes West 45 chains & 25 links then South to the place of beginning containing 131 acres.
