The people of the State of New York by the Grace of God free and independent: To all to whom these presents shall come, or may hereafter come, send Greeting: Know ye that at Johnstown in the County of Montgomery before James Lansing Esq. Surrogate of our said County the last Will and Testament of William Walradth deceased (a Copy whereof is herewith annexed) was proved and is now approved and allowed of by us and the said deceased having whols, the lield, and at the Time of his Death Goods Chattle or Credits within this State by means whereof the proving and registering the said Will and the granting Administration of all and singular the said Goods Chattle and Credits and also the auditing allowing and final discharging the Account thereof doth belong unto us, the Administration of all and singular the Goods Chattle and Credits of the said deceased and any way concerning his Will is granted unto Catharine Walradth Executrix & Adolph Walradth & Peter Walradth Executors in the said Will named they being first duly sworn well and faithfully to administer the same and to make and exhibit a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the said Goods Chattle and Credits and also to render a just and true Account thereof when thereunto required. In testimony whereof we have caused the Seal of Office of our said Surrogate to be herewith affixed. In the Name of God Amen I William Walradth of the Town of Canajohary and County of Montgomery in the State of New York being weak in Body but of sound Memory blessed be God do this eleventh Day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner & form following that is to say First and principally I commend my Soul into the Hands of allmighty God who gave it me and my Body to the Earth from whence it came in hopes of a full Pardon of all my Sins and a joyful Resurrection through the Merits and intercession of our blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ: And as for that worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God God to bless me me with I give devise and bequeath the same in manner and form following - First I give to my beloved Wife Catharine Walradth all my real & personal Estate so long as she remains my Widdow and one third of my real and personal Estate during her natural life, and I will that my Wife shall have the west Room in my House for her own use as long as she remains my Widdow. Item I give to my Son Peter Walradth the Farm I now live

live on with the Lease lot that joins my Farm to him his Heirs  
 and Assigns for ever he working the said Farm with his Brothers  
 until they come of age and using his Mother and me to do in  
 my life time - I give to my Son Peter Walradth my Waggon  
 my Bloughs my Harrow my Plays and Tackling that shall  
 be my property at the Time of my decease to him his Heirs  
 and Assigns for ever. I am I give to my Son Abraham Wal-  
 radth the two hundred pounds in Cash and a Span of Horses as  
 soon as he comes of age to be paid out of my Estate by my Son  
 Peter Walradth and a Sett of good Tackling and a good Saddle  
 and Bridle and a Horse besides the one he now owns. I am I  
 give to my Son Garret Walradth the two hundred pounds in Cash  
 and two Horses besides the one he now owns and a good Sett  
 of Tackling a good Saddle and Bridle as soon as he comes  
 of age to be paid by my Son Peter out of my Estate when  
 my Son Garret comes of age to him his Heirs and Assigns for  
 ever. I am I give to my Daughter Elize both Secker ten pounds  
 to her her Heirs and Assigns for ever - I will that the remain-  
 der of my personal Estate be divided between my three Sons  
 Peter Walradth Abram Walradth & Garret Walradth equal  
 Share & Share alike after my Wifes decease or when she is no  
 longer my Widdow to them their Heirs & Assigns for ever.  
 I make constitute and ordain my beloved Wife Catherine  
 Walradth my Executrix Adolph Walradth Peter Walradth  
 Executors to this my last Will & Testament they paying my  
 just Debts & funeral Expences six Months after my decease.  
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this  
 eleventh Day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and two. Signed sealed published and declared  
 by the said William Walradth as and for his last Will and  
 Testament in the presents of us who at his request and in  
 his presents and in the presents of each other have sub-  
 scribed our Names as Witnesses thereto. William Walradth (S).

 of Montgomery Charles Powell who being duly sworn deposite  
 and saith that he saw William Walradth sign & seal the  
 within Instrument & purporting to be the last Will & Testament  
 of the said William Walradth and that he heard him publish &  
 declare

declare the same as aaid for his last Will & Testament. And that the said William Wabradth was at the same time (according to the best of their knowledge & Belief of this Depoent) of sound & disposing Mind Memory & Understanding. And that the Name of this Depoent subscribed thereto as a witness is of his own proper writing. And that he at the same time saw Peter Wabrad and Joseph Wabrad subscribe their Names as Witnesses to the execution thereof. And that he together with the said Peter Wabrad & Joseph Wabrad subscribed as Witnesses in the presence of the Testator.
