To all to whom these presents shall come or may concern send Greeting. - Know ye, that at Johnstown in the County of Montgomery before James Lansing Esquire Surrogate of our said County the last Will and testament of Jacob A. Wabath deceased (a Copy whereof is herunto annexed) was proved and is now approved and allowed of by us and the said deceased having whilst he lived and at the time of his death Goods, Chattels or Credits within this State by means whereof the proving and registering the said Will and the granting administration of all and singular the said Goods, Chattels and Credits and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof doth belong unto us, the administration of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased and any way concerning his Will is granted unto David A. Quackenbush one of the Executors in the said Will named, he being first duly sworn well and faithfully to administer the same, and to make and exhibit a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the said Goods, Chattels and Credits; and also to render a just and true account thereof when thereunto required. - In testimony whereof we have caused the Seal of Office of our said Surrogate to be herunto affixed. this twenty ninth Day of June and in the twenty eight year
of independance and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & ten make ordaine publish and declare this my
last Will and testament that is to say principally and first of
all I give and recommend my immortal Soul after its departure
out of this frail body into the mercifull hands of God that gave
it me hoping and trusting for the pardon of my Sins and
transgressions in and thro' the death and passion of the blessed
Son of God Jesus Christ our savior and remainder and as for
my body I recommend to the Earth to be entred in a Christian
like maner at the deceasion of my Wife & Children and as for
such

such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to -
bles me with in this life after my just Debts and funerall
Charges be paid an satisfied I give devise & dispose of the
same in the following manner and to wit Imp^{um} 3 I give
to my eldest Son Gasper Wabrath and to his Heirs and Assignes
for ever one of my Sheep for his premienture warwith
he must be satisfied and make no other or further pre-
tence to any part of my Estate for being my Heir at law.
I steem to my loving Wife Mariah Wabrath all the
real Estate & personal property of my Cattle wich will
remain to be left on the place for the benefit and behoof
of the family during the decaise or unmarriage of my loving
Wife Mariah and then to be and remain to the use of my
Sun Adoff Wabrath and his Heirs for ever latterly I give
& bequeat unto my Son Gasper Wabrath one hundred -
Dollars & I also give unto my Sun George Wabrath one -
hundred Dollars & I give unto my Son John Wabrath one
hundred Dollars & I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth -
Sixty two Dollars & fifty Cents & I give unto Margrett my
Daughter Sixty two Dollars & fifty Cents & I give unto my
Daughter Caty Sixty two Dollars & fifty Cents from Moneis
wich is now due from Adam Bower in Kingston & the are
all to give and severally of them to recover this money -

by law if no sowner & each of them to pay their equal -
Share or Cost And if any there be overplus Monneys of the
Bower after each of them have thare for wich is inginde
upon them that I give unto my loving Wife Mariah Wal-
rath & I give unto unto my Daughter Cety one Cow one
heifer & one Sheep wich is to be deliverd to her from property
on the premises & I give unto my Sun John one Horse the
lobe & two Cows also from the Estate of my departure. & lastly
I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my good
freinds Christon Else and Jacob Walrath and David A.
Quackenbosc Executors of this my last Will and testament who
I hereby kindly desire to take care and see the same performed
according to my true intent and meaning and I do hereby
utterly disallow revoke & disannul all and every former testaments
and wills by me before this time made wiling that this and
no other heretofore by me made to be my last Will and testa-
ment & Wills by me before this time I witness whereof the said
Jacob A. Walrath have to this my last Will and testament set my

Be it remembered that on the twenty second Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen personally appeared before me James Lansing Surrogate of the County of Montgomery Jacob Wahath who being duly sworn deposeth and saith that he saw Jacob H. Wahath deceased sign the annexed Instrument (purporting to be his last Will and testament) by making his mark thereto and saw him seal the same and heard him publish and declare the said Instrument as and for his last Will and testament: That the said Jacob H. Wahath was at the time thereof (according to the best of the Judgment and belief of this Deponent) of sound and disposing mind memory and Understanding: That this Deponent subscribed his Name thereto as a witness to the execution thereof in the Testator's presence, and that he at the same time saw Christian Eitz (since deceased) and John C. Black, respectively subscribe their Names thereto as Witnesses to the execution thereof also in the presence of the said Jacob H. Wahath the Testator. -
