I Abraham Kalaich of the town of Fullinden
Montgomery County N.Y. do make publish &
declare this my last will & testament in manner
& form following. That is to say:

First. That out of my personal Estate my
Executors pay my just debts & funeral expenses, also
the funeral expenses of my beloved wife Eva, also
the expenses of erecting at our graves proper headstones.

Second. I give devise & bequeath to my beloved
wife Eva for & during her natural life the use &
enjoyment of all that part of my homestead dwelling
house now used & occupied by us together with all
the privileges in said house & the yards & outbuildings
connected with said house, we now use & enjoy -

And I also give unto my said wife during her life
the use & enjoyment of all my household furniture
and will & direct that she be furnished at each
dwelling house by my son Franklin with all the
coal & fuel she may require and with such farm
produce as she may require for use of such kinds
as may be raised & produced on the homestead farm
hereinafter devised to my son Franklin, And it is
my will & I hereby direct the executors of this my will
out of the income of my personal Estate furnish & provide
my said wife from time to time as may be required
sufficient money to procure all other necessary provis-
ions for her comfortable support & maintenance, and
such clothing & pocket money as she may desire
and also to provide her with a suitable housekeeper

& such other servants as may be necessary for her
with all necessary medical attendance -

Third. I give & devise unto my son Franklin Nalath
all my homestead farm situate in the town of Clinton
aforesaid, upon which I now reside subject to the
use & enjoyment & privileges of my wife herein as mentioned
in the second clause of this instrument and my
said son Franklin is hereby charged with furnishing
to my said wife his mother the fuel, coal & farm produce
mentioned in said second clause of this instrument
and my said son Franklin shall keep & maintain
my brother Daniel on said farm during his life in
the manner I have hitherto been accustomed to
keep & maintain him & provide him with all things
necessary for his comfort in sickness & in health -
and the bed & bedding now used by my said brother
shall be kept for his use as long as he lives -

Fourth. I give & bequeath to my daughters Maria
Elwood, Nancy Elwood & Matilda Evans, all the house-
hold furniture remaining at the death of my said
wife his mother, except the stove, carpets, likenesses
& pictures on the wall, book case & the two rocking
chairs used by myself & wife & the bed & bedding
used by my brother Daniel, which excepted articles
are to remain in my said house and to the property
of my son Franklin.

Fifth. I also give & bequeath unto my said daugh-
ters Maria, Nancy & Matilda each the sum of fifteen
hundred dollars payable after the death of my

said wife shall not be, should she survive me, but in the event of her death before my death, then such legacies to be paid one year after my death.

Sixth. The net residue of my estate after satisfying all the other provisions of this my will I give devise & bequeath unto my sons Henry Walrath, Josiah Walrath James Walrath, Alfred Walrath & Franklin Walrath share & share alike, but no division of my personal estate to be made during the lifetime of my said wife should she survive me -

Seventh - should my wife survive me it is my will & I hereby direct my executors to take charge of all my personal property except household furniture & after the payment of my debts & funeral expenses including headstone, the remainder thereof to be kept at interest during the lifetime of my said wife upon such securities as they may deem safe and prudent, and that such part of the income thereof not required to carry out the provisions herein made for my said wife be invested in the same manner.

Lastly I constitute & appoint my sons Henry Walrath & Josiah Walrath executors of this my will hereby revoking all other or former wills by me made -

I Abraham Walcott of the town of Ellwood
Montgomery County N.Y. do make publish & declare
this to be a codicil to my last will & testament
bearing date October 10th 1878 and to be taken as
a part of said will and hereunto annexed.

Whereas in & by the 6th sixth clause of
said last will & testament I have given the residue
of my estate after satisfying all other provisions
of said will to my sons Henry Walcott, Josiah Walcott
James Walcott, Alfred Walcott & Franklin Walcott
to be divided between them share & share alike
at the time mentioned in said sixth (6th) clause -

Now it is my will and I direct that all
notes or judgments I may hold against either of
my said sons at the time of my death no matter
whether barred by the statute of limitations or not -
shall be taken as part of my estate and in said
divisions the said notes or judgments I hold against
any of my said sons shall be taken as a part
of the share of each son, otherwise my will to
remain in full force.
