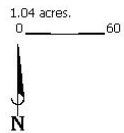

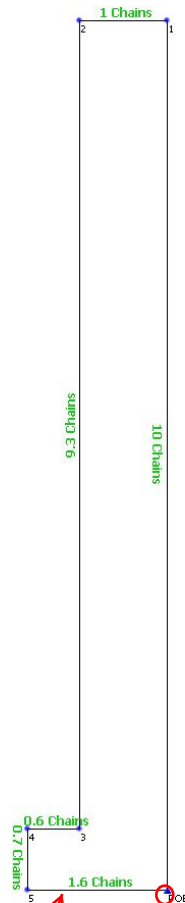

Description of land: Town of Palatine, Montgomery County, butted and bounded as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of land now in the possession of Rudolph Dygert then Northerly 10 chains then Westerly 1 chain then Southerly 9 chains & 30 links then Westerly 60 links then Southerly 70 links then Easterly 1 chain & 60 links as the Turnpike road runs to the place of beginning. The parties agree that no tavern or inn will be opened or kept on the premises.
