

**Abstract of Deed dated July 15, 1785**  
**Recorded April 27, 1811 by Jacob Snell**

Grantors: Garrit A. Lansing, Schenectady, Albany Co., N.Y.

Grantee: Henry Adolph Walrath, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Consideration: 250 pounds

Description of land: All that land, on which Henry Adolph Walrath possesses and lives on, being on the South side of the Mohawk River in the Town of Canajohary, being part of Lot Number 5 in a patent granted to Jacob Lansing, deceased, and others, the first parcel begins at the Southeast corner of Lot 5 and runs North 18 degrees East so far till with a line parallel to the South line of said whole lot it comprehends the quantity of 51 ½ acres going from East to West over the whole lot and one other parcel of 25 acres laying along the North side this tract between two parcels of land in the possession of Baltis Sutz which runs to the North of the whole Lot No. 5 as the land is now surveyed and also the ½ of all the land yet remaining in Lot No. 5 on the East side of the land of Baltis Sutz which ½ is to lay along the East side of said Lot and contains about 16 acres.
