Grantee: Henry A. Walrath, Oppenheim, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Description of land: All that certain piece or parcel of land in Oppenheim, being in a patent granted to George Klock, William Nellis, and others, and being the Westerly half of Lot Number twenty two, the whole lot being butted and bound by as follows: beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot number Twenty One and then North thirty five degrees East seventy one chains then North seventy five degrees and thirty minutes West sixteen chains then South thirty five degrees West seventy one chains and then to the place of beginning containing 100 acres.
