Grantee: Henry R.B. Walrat (sic), Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

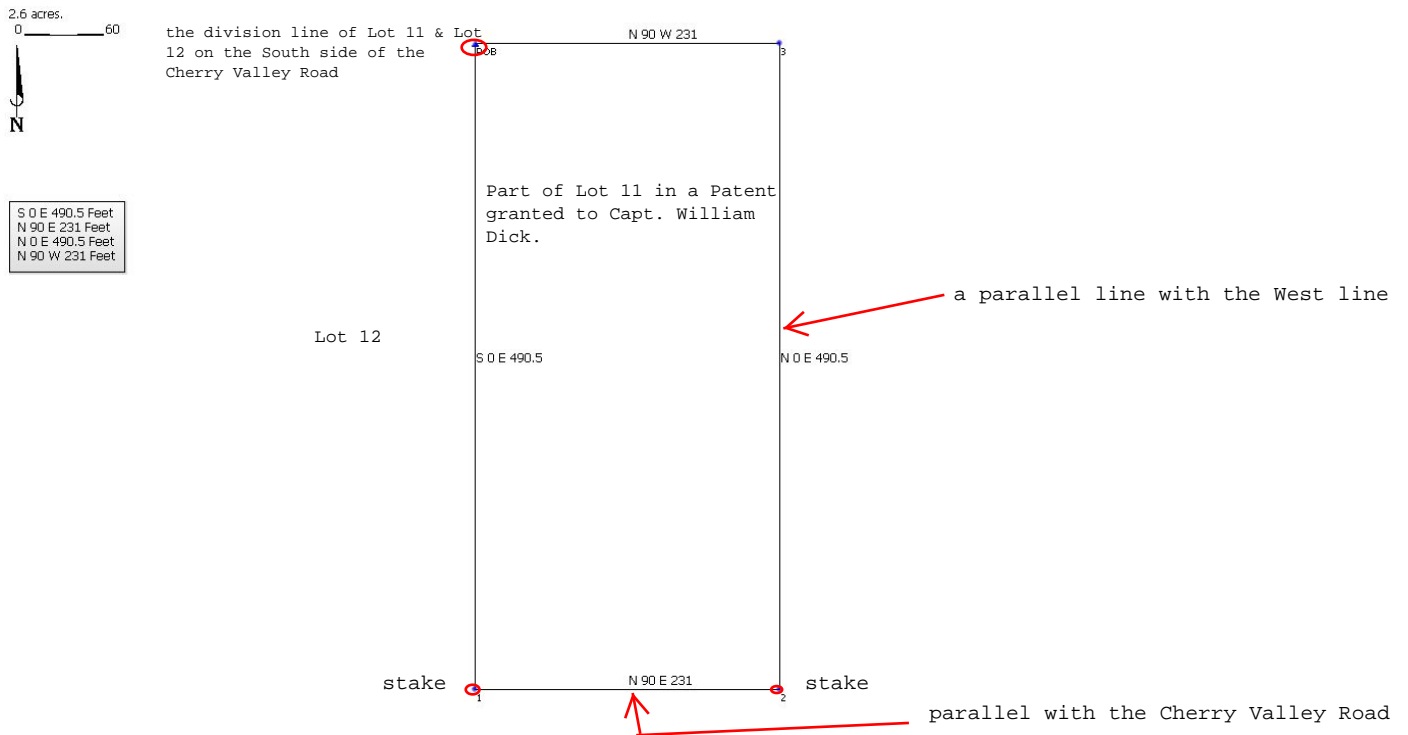
Consideration: \$100.00

Description of land: Part of Lot 11 in a Patent granted to Capt. William Dick. Beginning on the division line Lot 11 & Lot 12 on the South side of the Cherry Valley Road from there South as the line runs 29 rods and 12 feet to a stake then an Easterly course on a line parallel with the Cherry Valley Road 14 rods to a stake from there North on a parallel line with the West line 29 rods and 12 feet, from there a Westerly course as the Road runs 14 rods to the place of beginning containing 2 ½ acres and 9 rods of land.

In consideration of \$1.00 paid by Henry R. B. Walrad I hereby release all claim I have by mortgage or otherwise on the within described piece of land, witness my hand and seal this 22nd day of June 1829. David Little
