

Abstract of Deed dated April 17, 1822

Grantors: Jacob Walradt, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Grantee: John Jost Walradt, Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y.

Consideration: \$1,000.00

Description of land: In the Town of Canajohary, Montgomery Co., N.Y., Beginning on the division line of the lands Marte (sic) VanAlstine between him and his brother Cornelius VanAlstine at the River and running from there up the River 15 chains then keeping the same breadth striking into the woods 15 chains then West 3 chains then into the woods with the breadth of 18 chains & a Southerly course 47 chains to the lands heretofore granted to Jeremiah Quackenbush then Easterly along said Quackenbush line 18 chains and from there along said Cornelius VanAlstine line to the place of beginning excepting and reserving out of the above the lands heretofore granted & sold to Cornelius Wynkoop, John VanSlyck & Frederick Walradt.
