

Know all men, by these presents that I, Jacob A. Walrath Junior of the town  
of Oppenheim in the County of Montgomery & State of New York, do hereby  
agree to relinquish, and assign unto Christian C. Walrath of the same place,  
and by these presents, have, relinquished and assigned to the said Christian  
& Walrath, for and in consideration of ten dollars to me in hand paid  
all my right & title to cut wood on the farm now owned by said Christian  
& Walrath, but formerly by Adam A. Walrath deceased, hereby binding  
myself and my heirs to relinquish and to discontinue to cut any more wood  
on said above described premises, being part of lot number eighteen in the  
second patent given under my hand and seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November  
1835. Jacob A. Walrath Jr. (Seal) N.Y. The words and State of New York  
were interlined in the 1<sup>st</sup> line, & of the same place in the sixth line. In  
presence of Ashbel Loomis. State of New York & Montgomery County for  
I, Ashbel Loomis Commissioner of Woods in and for said County do certify  
that on the sixth day of November A.D. 1835. before me came Jacob A.  
Walrath Junior to me known and he acknowledged that he had executed  
the within instrument for the use and purposes therein mentioned and  
I finding therein no material interlineations or erasures (saving those noted)  
allow the same to be recorded. Ashbel Loomis.
