

**Abstract of Deed dated October 28, 1837
Recorded July 3, 1840
Montgomery Co., Book 46, Page 312-313**

Grantors: Malachi Kittle, Sheriff of Montgomery County, New York

Grantee: Charles Walrath (no place of residence noted)

Consideration: Three hundred sixty seven dollars (\$367)

Description of land: A parcel of land with buildings in the Town of Canajoharie butted and bounded Easterly by the Erie Canal, Southerly by the lands of G. Ver Plank, Westerly and Northerly by the lands of Joshua Webster, containing eleven acres of land, more or less.

Also for the sum of nine dollars, the highest amount bid, for a certain shop, a few rods westerly of a Wagon Shop now occupied by John D. Burk in the Village of Fort Plain, Montgomery County, New York, at and near Wagner's Mills between the highway and the raceway now occupied by Solomon Norton and all the estate and title which Daniel F. Cartis had in the premises

Note: The land of Daniel F. Cartis was sold pursuant to a writ of execution to satisfy a judgment awarded to Charles Walrath in the amount of Two hundred fifty eight dollars and nineteen cents (\$258.19).
