

This Indenture made the 18th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five Between the Trustees of the first Universalist Society in Mendon of the first part and Charles Walcott of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid have and by these presents do grant



Sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs or assigns the uninterupted use and enjoyment of one half of Slips No 45 in the Church erected and used by the said Society in the village of Port Plain so long as he or his assigns shall choose to use occupy and enjoy the same In witness whereof the said Trustees hereunto set their hands and caused the Seal of the said Society to be affixed the day and year above written
