Grantee: Adolph Walrath, Danube, Herkimer Co., N.Y.

Consideration: \$30.00

Description of land: Town of Minden, bounded on the North by the highway leading past the store formerly owned by John I. Zoller but now owned by John Davy at Fords Bush, on the East by a certain 1 acre lot this day conveyed by Sheldon Cronkhite to the Grantee, Adolph Walrath. The lot hereby conveyed being a strip extending along the West end or side of this 1 acre lot being in width where it bounds on the road 30 feet being now enclosed in and with this 1 acre lot and Adolph Walrath, the grantee, is to make and keep in repair the fence enclosing this lot including the strip and the 1 acre.
