Wabath of the town and County aforesaid have received released and forever quit claimed and By these presents do for my self my heirs executors and Administrators jointly and absolutely remise release and forever quit claim unto the said Jacob B Wabath and to his heirs and assigns forever quit claim ~~from~~ all such right and title as I the said Dorcas Garlock have or might have in or to all that certain farm piece parcel of land Situate lying and being in the town of Canajoharie County of Montgomery & State of New York bounded and described as follows viz Northwly by the lands of Peter G. Garlock easterly by the lands of William Garlock Southwly by a public highway westerly by the lands of Adam & Reuben Garlock containing about one hundred Acres of land be the same more or less and being the same farm of which Silas Garlock late of said town did seized and possessed to have and to hold the above released premises unto him the said Jacob B. Garlock his heirs and assigns to his their only proper use and behoof forever so that neither I the said Dorcas Garlock or any other person in my name and behalf shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises or any part thereof but they and every of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty, Dorcas Garlock
