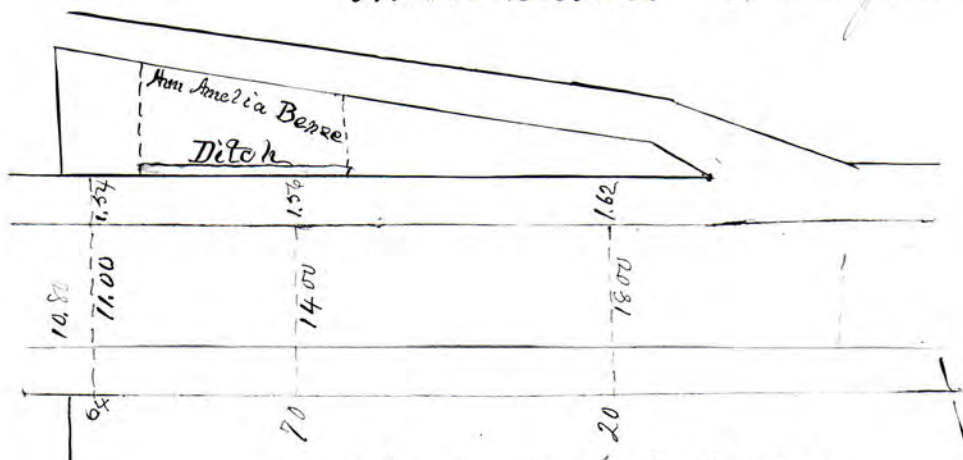
In the claim of Amelia Naboth

The Canal Appraisers heard this claim, at Canajoharie December 6th 1862, situate as above stated, after a personal examination of the premises, the claim is based upon an alleged appropriation in 1854, or thereabouts, by the State, of a part of Claimant's lands, for the construction of the Enlarged Erie Canal, and damages resulting therefrom the details of which will be found in the testimony received on the hearing. The annexed map is hereby made a part of this award. The amount hereinafter allowed embraces all items of injury to the property in question chargeable upon the State. It also includes the interest. Believing that the following will be a just and equitable estimate and appraisal of the Claimant's damages, we hereby allow and award her the sum of Two Hundred dollars, in full for all claims for damages in the premises.
